Transgender-Inclusive Healthcare Offerings

Gender-affirming care and services are covered by our medical plans and enhanced by programs to support your gender identity.

Covered Healthcare Services and Treatments Include:

- Mental health benefits
- Pharmaceutical coverage (hormone replacement therapies, including puberty blockers for youth)
- Coverage for medical visits and laboratory services
- Coverage for reconstructive surgical procedures related to gender reassignment (including reconstructive chest, breast, and genital procedures)
- Short-term medical leave

Depending on your carrier, additional benefits and procedures may be covered under the plan, when deemed medically necessary:

- Hair removal, such as electrolysis, laser treatment, etc. (not as a part of reconstructive surgery)
- Hair removal required for reconstructive surgery
- Tracheal shave/reduction
- · Facial feminization surgeries
- Voice modification surgery and therapy
- Lipoplasty/filling for body masculinization or feminization

Gender Affirming Coverage

All Medical Plans

Medical visits, laboratory services, prescription drugs and surgical procedures for gender-affirming care are covered at the same level of cost sharing as other services on our medical plans. To confirm coverage, please call the precertification number on the back of your ID card before you receive care. If you have questions, please use the number provided on the contacts page.

Family Formation

When you want to grow your family, we've got you covered. Our medical coverage includes artificial insemination without a medical diagnosis of infertility, and equal coverage of in-vitro services for both same and different-sex couples.

Family Services and Treatment Options

Cryopreservation:

Covered through health plan based on iatrogenic infertility (for example, infertility caused by chemotherapy) and requires a medical diagnosis.

Infertility treatment coverage (non-in-vitro):
 Covered through health plan

In-vitro fertilization:
 Covered through health plan

Parental leave:
 Available for adoptive and foster parents

Infertility Coverage

Medical Plans

Medical visits, laboratory services, prescription drugs and procedures for fertility services are covered at the same level of cost sharing as other services on our medical plans. To confirm coverage, please call the precertification number on the back of your ID card before you receive care. If you have questions, please use the number provided on the contacts page.

Infertility Lifetime Maximum: Medical \$25,000 and Rx \$10,000

HIV Services and Treatment

Medicines to treat HIV are safer and more effective than ever, and are covered by our medical plans.

Healthcare Services and Treatment Options

- · HIV testing including self-treatment options
- Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) including the injectable treatment
- Post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP)
- Antiretroviral therapy (ART) including the injectable treatment



HIV Coverage

Medical visits, laboratory services, prescription drugs and treatment for HIV are covered at the same level of cost sharing as other services on our medical plans. Employee Assistance Program

The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) provides counseling, legal support, and support for LGBTQ+ families and those who want to help support them.

Services Available:

- Counseling for mental health, suicide prevention, and other support, including referrals to LGBTQ+ informed counselors and service providers.
- Coming out resources, guides for supporting transgender children and youth.
- · Guides for workplace awareness and being an ally.
- · Legal services available to help with life events.
- Navigation to other LGBTQ+ resources.

Mental Health and Emotional Wellbeing

FAQ

Is gender-affirming treatment available on all health plans?

Gender reassignment surgeries, hormone replacement therapies, and other services are covered at in-network providers and facilities through most of our medical plans. Contact your carrier for coverage details.

Can I access legal and counseling services through the EAP even if I am not enrolled in a benefits plan?

Yes! The Employee Assistance Plan is available to all employees and family members.

How do I know if I am covered for infertility benefits?

Our health plans include infertility benefits for women without a male partner, including in-vitro fertilization and other services. Contact your carrier for coverage details.

Can I take family leave if I am adopting or fostering a child?

Yes! Please refer to myDXCbenefits.com for Leaves of Absence.

What should I do if I am experiencing discrimination in the workplace?
